1	<p><b>Public Session</b></p> <p>No representations were made.</p>

5	<p><b>Chairman's Report</b></p> <p>Throughout the year the Parish Council has made donations to both Memorial Hall and Church. The Queens 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday celebrations have also been supported. The Precept for the coming year shows a small increase to keep Finances in line with expected outgoings. The Chairman expressed his thanks to K. Sutton (District Councillor), E. Yates (County Councillor), Dave Airey (PCSO) and the Clerk for their support and help during the year.</p>
6	<p><b>Memorial Hall Report</b></p> <p>There are now 3 new Officers for the Memorial Hall Committee. The Chairman is Norman Fletcher, Secretary Is Rebecca Galley and the Treasurer is Matt Favell. The Finances of the Memorial Hall are currently being audited by the Charity Commission. The current balance of funds stands at about £2K. The Queens 90<sup>th</sup> Birthday Celebration events are going to plan.</p>
